Biographical Sketch

Can Eyigor is a professor of Anesthesiologist and Pain management physician at Ege University Medicine Faculty in Turkey. He received his residency training in Department of Anesthesiology (1997- 2002) in the Dokuz Eylul University Medicine Faculty. Then he started to work as an anesthesiologist in the Department of Algology at Ege University in 2005. Pain Board certificate was given by Turkish Algology Association in 2009. He has been appointed as an Associate Professor in 2011 and Professor in 2017 in the same department. He is still working in the Department of Algology at Ege University Medical Faculty.

He has specialized training in fluoroscopic guided minimally invasive interventional acute and chronic pain procedures as well as regional anesthesia techniques within this multidisciplinary pain clinic. His main interests are neuromodulation and regenerative stem cell therapies in chronic pain management. He has a lot of clinical experience with inpatients and outpatients. As a clinician educator, he teaches minimally invasive interventional pain techniques and medication management for medically challenging chronic pain patients to pain fellows and residents. He regularly gives lecture about chronic pain management in Turkey. He has been working as a practitioner on minimally invasive pain management procedures in different clinics. He was the author or co-author of numerous articles and book chapters in chronic pain management.
