Dr. Hemmo Boscher is a native from The Netherlands and attended medical school at “de Vrije Universiteit” in Amsterdam. He did his residency in anesthesiology at the University of Massachusetts in Worcester. In 2000, after a short career in anesthesiology, Dr. Bosscher did a pain management fellowship with Professor Gabor Racz in Lubbock, Texas. He started a pain management practice in Lubbock but retained an adjunct professorship at Texas Tech University, where he with the late Professor Dr. James Heavner continued his research in the field of epiduroscopy and epidural anatomy. In 2017 he obtained his doctorate in medical sciences under professor Dr. Kris Vissers at the Radboud University in the Netherlands. Over the years Dr. Bosscher and Dr. Heavner have published a number of papers with the objective to provide new insights into the pathophysiology of low back pain and on novel approaches to treat this very common and disabling condition.
